As the representative of Lauulu, I would like to relay some internet links to give everyone a historic understanding of what the MCC campus, Community Colleges (though outdated) and, UH System strategic plans are. Perhaps members of the committee may see a good fit for something on-going or, have an idea for a creative way to assure Goal 3 Objective 2 Action Strategies?
