- Research across curriculum




Biography Needs

- School-wide Biography initiative!
- Need injection of current biography figures, and fresh bindings/formats to attract readers
- Only 200 inventor/invention texts
 - SCIENCE STANDARDS NOT COVERED

What do we need?

- Background on biography needs
 - Only 5.36% of collection
 - Not fresh
- Science is at 10.92% of the collection
 - Less than 200 inventor/invention




The Law doesn't justify the Means...
