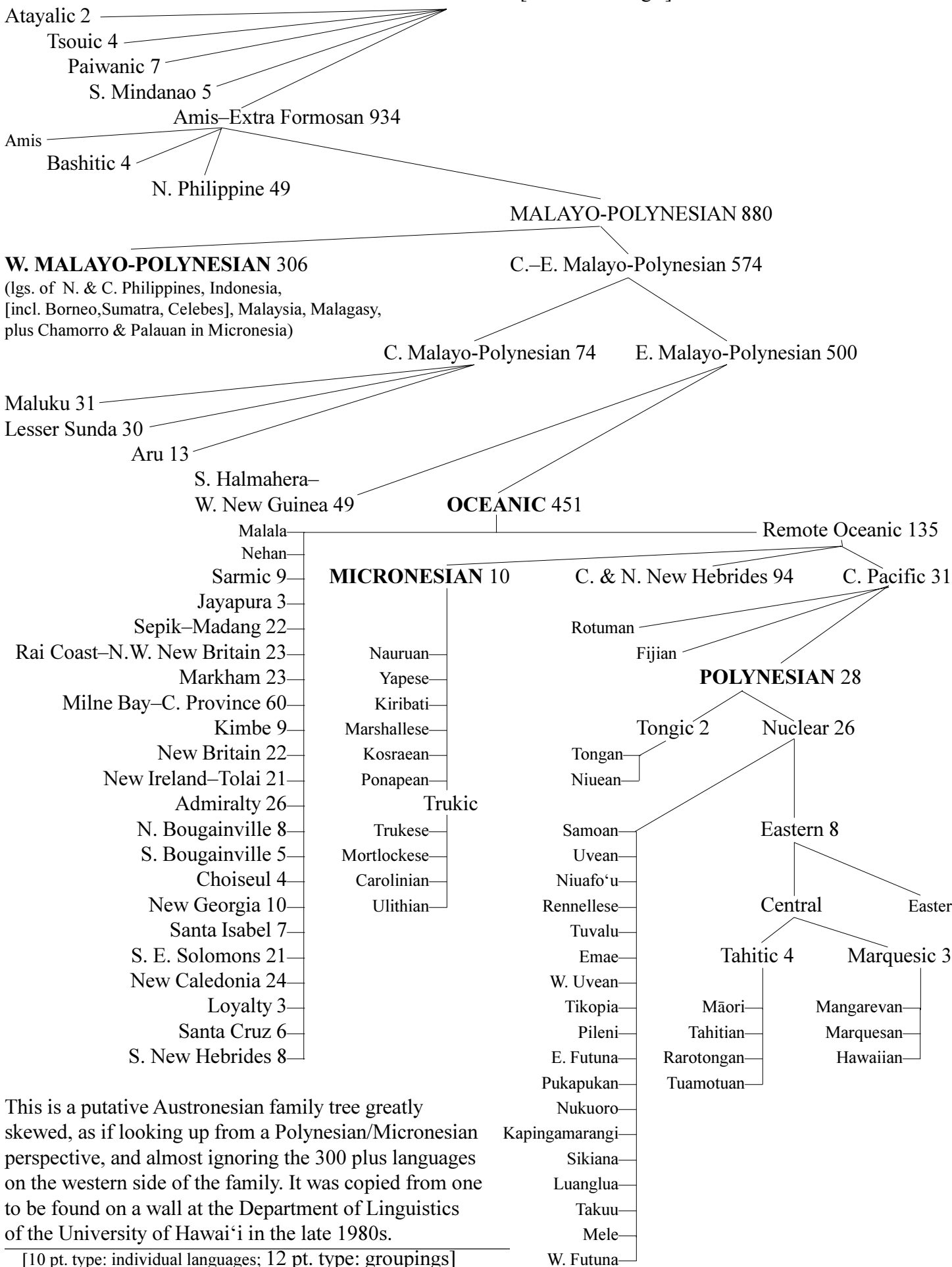


AUSTRONESIAN [952 = no. of lgs.]



This is a putative Austronesian family tree greatly skewed, as if looking up from a Polynesian/Micronesian perspective, and almost ignoring the 300 plus languages on the western side of the family. It was copied from one to be found on a wall at the Department of Linguistics of the University of Hawai'i in the late 1980s.
