Assignment 5

The objective of this assignment is to make you familiar with the rules in RDA 6.2, 6.27.1, 19.1, and 19.2 (and the associated LC/PCC PSes) and give you some practice in constructing authorized access points (AAPs) for works described in bibliographic records.

In addition to reading and interpreting the rules and PSes in 6.2, 6.27.1,19.1, and 19.2, you will also need to search the bibliographic and authority files in OCLC to complete these problems. Refer also to your Session 5 handout handout "Constructing authorized access points (AAPs) for works and expressions."

Below are ten (10) bibliographic citations. Each includes a transcription of data found on a resource's preferred source of information (RDA 2.2). Following each citation is a brief workform that you should complete with full MARC21 coding, indicators, and subfields to correctly identify the work embodied in the resource cited. Delete unneeded fields from each workform after you complete it. Use # to show that and indicator is blank and \$ as the subfield delimiter.

For each citation, please write a short explanation (typed, double-spaced please) of what decisions you made, what rules you consulted, rtc.
