

## Assignment 9

In this assignment, you will transcribe descriptive data for six 6) printed textual monographs. For one of the six (which will be assigned to you in class), you will also construct an AAP for the work embodied in the manifestation you are cataloging, and provide AAPs for other persons associated with the work (if applicable), and provide LCSH subject heading strings in 6XX for the subject(s) of the work.

You should consult the rules and LCPs referenced in the table in #8 of your session 9 handout (<http://www2.hawaii.edu/~chohey/ho1Sess9.pdf>), the other handouts from session 9 ([ISBD cheat sheet](#) and [physical description of texts](#)) and all other applicable handouts from earlier sessions. You will need to consult the OCLC authority files for names and subjects in the one resource assigned to you. **Do *not* consult any OCLC bibliographic records for this assignment.**

1. Examine each textual resource's title page and title page verso (see below).
2. Use the Connexion browser or client to create a new MARC21 bibliographic record for each the resource using BOOKS workform:

3. When you have finished creating your record, make a printout to bring to class and hand in with your essay answers on March 19.
4. Submit an essay (typed, double-spaced, please) in class on March 19 outlining the RDA rules and LC-PCCPSes you consulted in creating your record, other resources you consulted, decisions you made, questions you had, etc.

Your completed bibliographic record for each of the six descriptive records should contain at minimum:

[Ramakrishna and His Disciples](#) (AAPs, etc. provided by Andrea)

You'll have to guess the subject matter of this book from the title or find out from amazon.com or somewhere. The first page with text on it is not numbered. Next five pages are numbered ii-vi. Then the following pages are numbered 7-331. The height of the book is 9 inches = 22.8 centimeters = 228 millimeters. The width is 14.8 centimeters.

[Records of a Girlhood](#) (AAPs, etc. provided by Matthew)

This a memoir. Ignore the pencil-written annotations on the title page (like the pencil-written "E" after "ANN". The pages in it are numbered i to xiii, and then there are two pages with no numbering on them, and then the following pages are numbered 3 to 589, and then the last page with text on it has no numbering, and then there are 4 blank pages. The height of the book is 8 inches = 20.4 centimeters = 204 millimeters. The width is 5 inches.

[Japan and Pacific Free Trade Area](#) (AAPs, etc. provided by Monica)

You will have to guess the subject matter of this book from its title or find out from amazon.com or somewhere. The pages in it are numbered iii to

xvi, and then 2-195. The height of the book is 10 inches = 25.5 centimeters = 255 millimeters. The width is 138 millimeters.

[Memoir of William Ellery Channing](#) (AAPs, etc. provided by Soledad)

This is a memoir of William Ellery Channing. You can find out about him in Wikipedia or elsewhere online. This memoir you are cataloging was published in 3 volumes, and you're cataloging the 3-volume set on one bibliographic record based on the preferred sources of information for volume 1 (volume 1 title page and t.p. verso). You also need to know that volume 3 was published the year following the year volume 1 was published. (Volume 2 was published in between v.1 and v.3.) The height of volumes 1 and 2 is 8 inches = 20.4 centimeters = 204 millimeters. The height of volume 3 is 10 inches = 25.5 centimeters = 255 millimeters. The width of all of them is 5 inches.

[African Politics in South Africa](#) (AAPs, etc. provided by Ellie)

This book is about the involvement of Black Africans in the politics and political parties of South Africa in the period 1964-1974. The pages in it are numbered iii to xi, and then 1-276. The height of the book is 8 inches = 20.4 centimeters = 204 millimeters. The width is 10 inches = 25.5 centimeters = 255 millimeters.

[Autobiography, Diary, and Correspondence of James Freeman Clarke](#)

(AAPs, etc. provided by Thumy)

This book contains the entirety of James Freeman Clarke's diary, autobiography, and all of his surviving written correspondence. You can find out about him in Wikipedia or elsewhere online. The pages in the book are numbered 3-430, but there is also a big section in the middle of the book which contains 60 unnumbered pages of plates (pictures, portraits, and some reproductions of Clarke's manuscripts). Those 60

unnumbered pages are printed on one side of the page only (whereas all of the book's numbered pages of text are printed on both sides). The height of the book is 8 inches = 20.4 centimeters = 204 millimeters. The width is 5 inches.
