

**ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)
Pre-Admissions Exam for the KCC ADN, LPN-RN Transition, and PRCN Program
Administered at the Kapi'olani Community College Testing Center in Lama Library**

LOCATION

Lama Library, Room 101. Check-in at the Testing Center front counter.

TESTING DATES (See reverse/second page for specific test dates)

In Fall 2017: **September 5, 2017 – November 17, 2017** (to meet the Sept 15 PRCN app deadline)

In Spring 2018: **January 16, 2018 – April 27, 2018** (to meet the Feb 1 ADN/TRANS app deadline and May 15 PRCN app deadline).

TESTING DAYS and START TIMES

Monday to Thursday: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon

Friday: 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.

TESTING FEES – both fees will be processed during check-in.

(1) Proctoring Fee: \$65 (cash or check only) **(2) Online ATI Test Fee:** \$58 (credit or debit card only)

REGISTRATION IS NOW REQUIRED. SEATING IS LIMITED. To register, just follow steps 1 – 3 below.

Note: Registration for all exam dates begins August 14, 2017.

Step 1: Check the Seat Availability Calendar.

- The calendar shows the number of seats available for testing on that date.
- Information on the calendar is not displayed in real time, but will be updated as registrations are processed.
- **BLACKOUT DATES:** ATI TEAS tests will not be available on application deadlines and during certain times of year (midterms, final exams, and Spring and Winter breaks, weekends, and holidays). A listing of exceptions to the regular available test dates are listed on the back of this sheet.

Step 2: Register online for a test date.

- Students are required to register online through the Testing Center URL above.
- Register early: We use a rolling registration system. Test dates for *each week* will close to new registrations on the Friday prior at 3:30 p.m. (See reverse/second page for registration deadlines)
- Select up to THREE (3) different test dates: your *preferred* test date, and two (2) *alternate* dates.
- All online registrations are date/time stamped, and will be processed in the order received.
- Be flexible. If there are no seats for any of the dates you selected, the Testing Center will contact you by phone or e-mail to re-schedule your test on a date with available seats.
- PLEASE BE PATIENT FOR A RESPONSE. We will process test registrations as quickly as possible.

Step 3: Check your e-mail.

- Your ATI TEAS *Exam Admission Ticket* will be sent to you via an e-mail attachment.
- **IMPORTANT!!** Your ATI TEAS *Exam Admission Ticket* is a REQUIRED document for entry into the testing room. Print it out and bring it with you.
- Your ATI TEAS *Exam Admission Ticket* will list your scheduled test date, check-in times, and list important fees and documentation you need to bring with you to the Testing Center.
- Take a few minutes to read [pages 2 and 3](#) of your *Exam Admission Ticket* to become familiar with exam procedures and regulations, and important information about the ATI TEAS test, study guides, passing scores, and re-test policies.

EXCEPTIONS TO THE TEST DATES ABOVE

NO TESTING on KCC Nursing Application Deadlines: September 15, 2017, February 1, 2018, and May 15, 2018.

NO TESTING on these holidays: Sept 4 (Labor Day), Nov 10 (Veterans Day), Jan 15 (MLK Day), Feb 19 (Presidents Day)

PASSING SCORE:

Kapi'olani CC Applicants: For the ADN and LPN-RN Transition program, students must achieve an adjusted individual total score of **78% or higher (or equivalent scaled score)**. For the PRCN program, students must achieve an adjusted individual total score of **65% or higher (or equivalent scaled score)**. *Please check the nursing program or ATI-TEAS webpage on the KCC website for special announcements regarding changes to the passing scores via a pilot study, **wherein 60% or higher will be considered for the PRCN program, while 65% or higher will be considered for the ADN and TRANS programs.***

Applicants to Other Colleges: Check with your school's nursing department for this information.

RE-TEST POLICY:

Kapi'olani CC Applicants: You may re-test once every three (3) months). Scores for tests taken within a three-month period will not be considered and the Nursing Department may deny your application for admission for the semester you are trying to enter. The highest score will be used if the test was taken more than once.

Applicants to Other Colleges: You must know and abide by your school's re-test policies.

SCORE VALIDITY:

Kapi'olani CC Applicants: Your ATI TEAS score is valid for three (3) years.

Applicants to Other Colleges: Check with your school's nursing department for this information.
