Produced by Palm Pictures and Chris Blackwell (Bob Marley's label and manager), 1 Giant Leap celebrates, through magnificent music, spoken word, and imagery, the unity of spirit that runs deep beneath all cultures and speaks/sings to the challenges and joys of all the people of our planet.

The 2nd Leap is now being recorded in 20 countries over the next 5 months with Jamie and Duncan currently in Mali, Africa for their first segment. As in the initial 1 Giant Leap DVD, all performers are recorded in their country of origin, with the global performances woven together in a cutting edge multimedia post-production effort which has earned several Grammy nominations and rave reviews.

Local Hawaii Leap co-coordinators are currently looking for performers and every day people of all our cultures that represent the Spirit of the Islands in song or dance or music or wisdom for the segment representing Hawaii, to be recorded here on Maui February 12<sup>th</sup> to the 19<sup>th</sup>.
