### Trainee Conduct Code

The University of Hawaii has a Student Conduct Code with policy for breaches. The faculty will follow this policy in the event of a breach. Examples of academic misconduct include, i.e., positioning an examination paper so that others can see the answers or passing or sharing answers during the exam, breaking confidentiality of patient information/records, fabricating write-ups such as history and physicals, documentation of actions not performed, photocopying patient records for personal use, knowingly performing skills for which you do not know the proper techniques, plagiarizing, verbally or physically threatening behavior directed toward patients, faculty, other students, or staff, abuse of academic resources, failure to return texts, resources or equipment checked out from the MCH LEND Project, or not reporting damage to equipment at the time it occurs.
