- In response to the opening screen asking you to “select article type”, select the option: “MFA Conference 2016 and LUMS Conference 2016 SI: Islamic Banking and Finance IV”
- Complete all remaining requested information on EES as per a normal PBFJ manuscript submission

Other Important Information:

- **Submission Deadline:** Papers can be submitted immediately after the LUMS Conference for the special issue but no later than: **August 15, 2016**
- Standard PBFJ **submission fee** is required since all manuscripts are subject to the Journal's normal review process.

- The acceptance deadline (the date by which all manuscripts should be fully reviewed and final decisions made on all manuscripts; and those failing to meet the deadline may be excluded): **May 31, 2017**
- The expected publication date of the Special Issue: **September 2017**
