I, ANTOINETTE LEE, being first duly sworn, on oath, deposes and says that:

1. I am an alumna of Kamehameha Schools, graduating class of 1959.
2. For the past 30 years I have been a volunteer for Kamehameha Schools Bishop Estate.
3. Whenever assistance was needed with the Christmas Concert, the Song Contest and graduation, the school knew I was capable and willing to help and they regularly called me to do so.
4. For 30 years I was one of KSBE's principal volunteers.
5. Graduates and people in the community told me they thought I was employed by Kamehameha because I was always at all of the events.
6. When Alumni week started I volunteered to take a week of vacation to assist in helping to put the Alumni week on. I did that for about 6 years.
7. I have been the President of Na Pua a Ke Ali'i Pauahi from 1997 to date.
8. Just prior to the protest march I did go public on television asking Alumni, parents and friends to please participate in a march to protest the Trustees' refusal

to meet with our parent-student-alumni group to discuss the current crisis on campus.

9. Immediately after Na Pua's protest march on May 15, 1997, I received a letter from Marlene Sai's office "The Alumni and Parent Advancement Center" stating that my assistance was no longer needed.
10. I believe I was "fired" as a volunteer as a means to intimidate me into discontinuing my Na Pua activities.
10. I believe that my constitutional right has been taken away from me.
11. I have also been my class of 1959 representative for 39 years.
12. Many have expressed to me that they are fearful of what will happen to them and their Ohana if they join Na Pua.
13. I believe many alumni are fearful for their children, for their scholarships and future relatives that will attend Kamehameha.
